Use this checklist to help you maintain your cochlear implant.

| | Task | Notes |
|-----------|--|-------------------------------|
| Daily | | |
| | Wear your cochlear implant as much as possible during waking hours. | |
| | Check your microphone, processor, and transmitter or headpiece for damage, dirt, and/or moisture. | |
| | Frequently clean the external parts of your cochlear implant. Clean your hands and then clean the parts with a dry, nonabrasive cloth. | |
| | Store your cochlear implant in a desiccation system to remove moisture, including humidity and sweat. | |
| Monthly | | |
| | Replace microphone protectors or covers at least once every three months. | |
| As needed | | |
| | Always keep back-ups of your cochlear implant parts. | |
| | Avoid water damage by removing your cochlear implant before entering a pool or shower. | |
| | Replace batteries in your processor when needed. | Manufacturer recommendations: |
